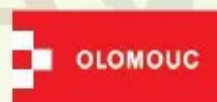

PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Application forms are to be sent online via www.dogoffice.cz or by email floracanis@seznam.cz (in both cases our confirmation will be sent back). Forms can be also sent by mail to the organizer's address. The show fee includes admission for one person and a catalogue. The payment can be paid as following:

- A) Bank transfer – bank account number: 4968526379/0800, IBAN: CZ91 0800 0000 0049 6852 6379, reference: the applicant's telephone number in the application form
- B) Postal ticket type A

The payment will be refunded only in case the application form is not accepted. In case the applicant cancels the application the payment is not refunded. If the show is not held for force majeure reasons (veterinary precautions, natural disaster etc.), the payments will be used to pay the show expenses. The form must be sent with payment confirmation. Please be aware of the deadline dates as the date of the show fee delivery to the organizer's account is decisive for the fee amount. The application forms will not be accepted without the payment confirmation and fee delivery to the account. Please note: Every form must include a both-side pedigree photocopy, photocopies of other documents necessary for placement in the working or champion classes.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The forms must be filled in block letters. Each dog has its own application. Illegible forms will not be accepted. Discount for the second and other dogs can only be applied if the owner's name is identical with the first application. The organizer is not responsible for the incorrectly filled forms. If the application does not include the photocopy of the documents entitling the dog for the working or champion classes, the dog will be placed in the open class. Each dog can enter only one class. Changing classes after the third deadline is not possible. Exhibitors will receive their entry sheet (electronic/written) with the show date about ten days before the show. If not, it is possible to check the form approval at www.floracanis.cz in the exhibitors list. In case the exhibitor's name is not found in the list, it is necessary to contact the dog show office to find out the reason. Contact: floracanis@seznam.cz, +420 585 427 644, +420 731 031 818. After the form is approved, the exhibitor accepts the ČMKU Show Regulations and the Show Instructions. Exhibitors agree with publishing their addresses in the show catalogue. Any documents delivered after the last deadline will not be accepted.

CLASSES

Classes placement follows the ČMKU Show Regulations and is stated in the application form. For the working class exam the certificate is required. Champion and honour class placement requires previous awards/titles: National winner, Club winner, Special show winner, Champion of the Czech Republic, ČMKU Champion, Interchampion, Champion of any FCI country member,

European winner, World winner and a photocopy of winning the title must be attached. The titles mentioned must be received in adult classes. There is no CAC in the honour class and Excellent 1 does not compete for the National winner, BOB or BOS. Characters (colour, size, hair type) of some breeds are judged separately due to FCI or ČMKU regulations. Titles are not to be claimed.

TITLES (must meet ČMKU Regulations, par.6)

CAJC, CAC ČR, CAC ČMKU, Res. CAC, National winner, Best of Breed – BOB, Best of Opposite Sex – BOS, Best of Junior – BOJ, Best of Veteran – BOV, Best Couple, Best Breeder's Group, Best Baby, Best Puppy, Junior Best in FCI Group – BIG, Junior Best of Day – JBOD, Junior Best in Show – JBIS, Best in FCI Group – BIG, Best of Day – BOD, Best in Show – BIS. Titles are not to be claimed. In every class the first best four are selected with the award of very promising or promising, excellent or very good.

COMPETITIONS

Junior Handling – age groups: I. 9-13 year-olds, II. 13-17 year-olds, concerning reaching the date of birth a day before the show. Competition is possible with a dog registered in the FCI breed registry, it is not necessary to have the dog judged at the show, but competition is possible only with the breed judged at the particular day of the show. Presenting of a dog is judged, not its qualities. Points received at national and international shows can be included in national, yearly competition.

National Grand Prix (BONB) – for all representatives of Czech national FCI and NON FCI breeds, including československý vlčák (Czechoslovak Wolfdog). Only dogs awarded BOB compete.

Best Baby – all male and female dogs awarded very promising one in the baby class compete

Best Puppy – all male and female dogs awarded very promising one in the puppy class compete

Best Veteran – all male and female dogs awarded BOV compete

Best of Honour Class – all male and female dogs awarded excellent 1 in the honour class compete

Best Couple – a male and female of one breed and character judged at the show and owned by the same owner compete

Best Breeder's Group – 3 to 5 representatives of one breed and character judged at the show, originated from one breeder, born to at least 2 different mothers or fathers compete

Junior Best in FCI Group (JBIG) and NON FCI – representatives of groups awarded BOJ compete

Best in Group (BIG) – representatives of FCI groups and NON FCI awarded BOB compete

Junior Best of Day (JBOD) – representatives awarded JBIG compete

Best of Day – representatives awarded BIG compete

Junior Best in Show – representatives awarded JBOD compete

PRIZES

All dogs judged will receive a report and an award certificate. BOB, BOS, BOJ, NW, CAC – cups, medals, cockades. Group winners – prizes, cups, dog dry food, JBOD – a smart phone Huawei, dog dry food, BOD – a smart phone Huawei, a cup, dog dry food, JBIS – a tablet, a cup, dog dry food, BIS – a laptop, a cup, dog dry food

VETERINARY REQUIREMENTS

~x All entering animals must be healthy.

~x All dogs must have a pet passport or veterinary certificate proving valid vaccination against rabies.

All dogs from the EU and third countries must have a valid EU Pet Passport and must meet conditions stated by the EU Parliament and Council 998/2003 from 26/5/2003.

During the dog show all dogs must be supervised so that they do not cause any damage/injury to other dogs or humans.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

The exhibition is open to males and females of all breeds registered in the breed registry recognized by the FCI that reached the age required for class on the day of the show. Organizers are not responsible for any damage caused by a dog or an exhibitor, or for dog loss or death during the exhibition. Dogs are not allowed to move in the area of the show without supervision. Dogs with cropped ears are not allowed to enter the show and will not be judged. The show is not open for females in season, females in the second half of pregnancy, nursing females and aggressive individuals. It is forbidden to treat the coat, skin or nose of the dog with anything that changes their texture, colour or shape. It is forbidden to treat the dog in the show grounds, using any substances or equipment. Only cutting, trimming, combing or brushing is allowed. It is also forbidden to tie the dog on the trimming table at the show longer than necessary. Violation of the regulations may result in immediate expulsion from the show. Owners of the dogs awarded the title BOB are obliged to participate with their dogs in the final competitions. Exhibitors are required to comply with the FCI Show Regulations and ČMKU Regulations, the instructions mentioned above and the instructions of Show Committee, which they confirm by submitting the application form. Exhibitors pledge to maintain order in the exhibition area. In case the show is cancelled due to force majeure, the fees will be used to cover the expenses. Selling puppies at the show is prohibited.

PROTEST

A protest against any decision made by the judge is not acceptable. A protest can be submitted for formal reasons such as violation of show regulations and show instructions. The protest must be submitted in written form with a principal sum of 1300 CZK (double show fee for the first dog at the first deadline), only during the course of the show. In case the protest is found to be unjustified, the sum will be forfeited to the organizer of the show.

NOTIFICATION

Exhibitors whose dogs at the Floracanis Dog Show will get the last necessary CACs for the title Czech Champion, Czech Junior Champion, Czech Grand Champion, Czech Veteran Champion and ČMKU Champion are welcome to bring the necessary documents to the show office, where the award certificates will be distributed from 10.30 a.m. to 3 p.m. For this reason the original CAC card, at least a pedigree copy and for working breeds a working certificate copy are required. The fee is 200 CZK for Czech exhibitors, 20 EUR for foreign exhibitors.
